

- Rockwell's Contrologix, RSView HMI, SLC welding controllers, and motion controllers along a 25 m forming line
- 51 Ethernet devices connected by CTRLink 8-port and 16-port unmanaged switches
- EtherNet/IP replaced earlier Data Highway network


#### **KeyMaster Card Access Operates over Ethernet**

- ControlSoft's KeyMaster card access system is based upon ARCNET
- KeyMaster is used by American Auto-Matrix as part of their building automation system
- Needed to connect ARCNET to an Ethernet backbone
- An AI-SRVR was used as an ARCNET server to Ethernet

AI-SRVR The AI-SRVR can AI-SRVR operate in proxy mode requiring no special software. A pair of servers tunnel ARCNET messages over **Ethernet** transparently.






#### **Chicago Office Building Upgraded to Ethernet**

- HVAC, lighting, access control systems upgraded by installing Tridium's Niagara Framework running BACnet/IP
- All systems including life-safety, video surveillance, and security centralized into one control room
- All systems operate over 10/100 Mbps Ethernet using Skorpion plug & play switches to a server room







#### **Data Center Automation Uses Ethernet**

- Automated Logic Corporation (ALC) system controlling the cooling of a data center
- 100 computer room air-conditioners, emergency generators, 10 UPS systems, and roof-top chillers all being controlled
- BAS Switches used for Ethernet communication



The shallow depth of the BAS Switch makes it ideal for mounting with other BAS equipment.






# **Modernization of Railroad Maintenance Facility**

- Compact Managed Switch connects to PLCs and HMIs within the maintenance facility





- 32 sensors used to measure and record energy usage












